How to Overcome Ageism in a Job Search

- Start from Scratch

Now's a good time to do a complete "job search makeover." As impartially as you can, assess how you stack up as a job candidate in today's competitive market, where you're likely up against people of all ages whose accomplishments may well be on par with yours.

- Revamp Your Resume

Your credentials may be extensive, but resist the urge to exhaustively list everything you've achieved in your career. "Hiring managers want to see the most current and relevant experience you have for the specific job you are applying to, so it's really only necessary to go back 10-15 years in your work history," advises Toni Frana, one of FlexJobs' Career Experts.

Update your resume, and don't feel obligated to include specific but long-ago dates on your resume that may unnecessarily call attention to your age. When you write your cover letter, exclude items that could give away your age, like saying you have excellent references. These days, it's expected you have excellent references, so there's no need to mention it.

- Consider Flexible Work

If you believe you're experiencing ageism in your job search, consider flexible jobs, like part-time roles. Look for positions with smaller companies or startups, where professional part-time jobs and contract or project-specific positions may be a more viable option than in bigger or more established companies.

Remote jobs, which tend to require less face time and more emphasis on work accomplished, can also work well for older workers. Working with a team of younger coworkers may be easier when the focus is on your work performance and not your appearance in the office. Be sure your tech skills are up to par if you want to go this route.

- Leverage Your Expertise

Consider launching a website or a blog where you can highlight your expertise in an area where your skills shine. This is an option if you truly have a deep level of expertise in your career field, a little technical know-how, and your writing skills are top-notch.

Use contacts in your network to provide posts and comments—and maybe a glowing commendation or two about how good you are at what you do to help overcome ageism in a job search.

- Stay Up to Date

Learning never ends! Use that as a guiding principle to keep you motivated and stay abreast of technological advances and job trends. Employees who started working when things were done on paper and with typewriters need to stay current with trends and technology in order to move to an integrated, often global workforce.

Taking classes and embracing new technology will keep you competitive and employable. Using social media tools like LinkedIn and Twitter shows a level of comfort and youthfulness in your job search.

- Pick the Right Employer

While some employers discriminate based on age, there are many that don't and are also fantastic places for people over 50 to work. For example, the Age-Friendly Institute identifies companies that are supportive and welcome older workers. What's more, many of these companies also hire for flexible roles.

Regardless of age, assessing a company's culture is important when looking for a new role. Do you agree with the company's policies, corporate culture, and industry? Knowing that you believe in a company and your ability to match with its environment can help you focus on the job you want.

- Know the Benefits of Age Diversity

Not everyone considers having a range of ages within an organization a benefit. But younger workers and older workers alike can bring different skills that are valuable.

Older workers may have more traditional business skills, such as better in-person and written communication abilities. Having a mix of ages can help a company reach different clients. And older workers can also act as mentors to pass along their knowledge and expertise in areas where others may be lacking.

- Watch for Interview Red Flags

It is illegal to ask certain questions in interviews. That said, not every question in an interview or on an application is illegal but could be asked to determine your age. For example, while it is illegal to ask for your birthdate or your age, it's not illegal to ask questions like: What year did you graduate high school?

How long have you been in the workforce?

Will the age gap between you and your coworkers bother you?

Will this position challenge you or will you be bored?

If you're asked any of these questions, focus on what the intent is behind them. The interviewer may be wondering about your technical know-how, if you have the experience needed for the role, and if you will be able to devote the amount of time needed. Circle back to your expertise and skills to show how you can do the job, no matter your age.



SCSEP Program Requirements

- Participants must be at least 55
- Unemployed
- Family income of no more than 125% of the federal poverty level

Enrollment priority is given to veterans and qualified spouses of veterans, then to individuals who are over 65, have a disability, have low literacy skills or limited English proficiency, reside in a rural area, are homeless or at risk of homelessness, have low employment prospects, or have failed to find employment after using services through the American Job Center system or are formerly incarcerated or on supervision from release from prison or jail within five years of the date of initial eligibility determination.
